- a) W/11/02345/PN Spa Housing Association Ltd –Erection of eight new affordable houses on land off Field Barn Lane (north west) Following a Parish Meeting on Friday December 16th 2011 an objection has been filed and the decision from the Planning Committee on Thursday 5th January 2012 was to defer the application on design & siting, after having sympathy for access and infrastructure problems which were not strong enough to overcome affordable housing shortages. Consultation with the Parish Council and neighbours took place on 21st February and the final plans have now been received for 4 off 3 bedroom & 2 off 2 bedroom house plus 2 off 2 bedroom bungalows. A further Parish Meeting on 20th March 2012 decided to continuing objecting to the 'out of place' design. WDC approved the application subject to s106 restrictions at a Planning Committee Meeting on 26th April 2012.

- c) W/12/00610/CA Mr J Carver, Southern Court, Main St Demolition of existing dilapidated greenhouse, boathouse & outbuilding A no objection response was filed and a decision is awaited.
- d) W/12/00609/CA Mr J Carver, Southern Court, Main St Proposed relocation of garage as approved under planning approval W/09/0849/PP, swimming pool enclosure structure with integrated solar panels on roof, and replacement boat house A no objection response was filed and a decision is awaited.
