#### 13/01617/OUT WPC Comments Lodged 01 April 2014

- 1) additional burden on volume of traffic on a road net work (M5 to Norton and ketch island) that is already over stretched in respect of volume (and the widening of the norton to ketch island is unlikely to resolve or reduce the problem as the bridge will remain one carriageway in either direction, and
- 2) the developers should be asked to contribute to pedestrian and cycling safety by supporting a controlled pedestrian crossing to and from the new development giving access to St. Peter's (Tesco etc) and Norton (garden centre/sports facilities etc). This will have a direct impact on those residents of St. Peter's who are Wychavon and Whittington parishioners.
