ALL ATTENDEES ARE ASKED TO ENSURE THEIR PHONES OR OTHER MOBILE DEVICES ARE SET ON SILENT OR VIBRATE MODE DURING MEETINGS, TO MINIMISE DISRUPTION OR DISTURBANCE TO OTHERS ATTENDING THE MEETING.

RECORDING OF MEETINGS

Admission to Meetings Act 1960 s.1(9). The use of social media, filming, photographing and audio recording in formal meetings is permitted for members of the public, press and Councillors who are not members of the meeting which is taking place and so long as this (in the view of the Chairman) does not undermine or disrupt the meeting. The full attention of Councillors must not be distracted by using social media or any mobile devices.

These concessions do not apply following a motion to exclude the press and public from any part of the meeting. No Councillor in attendance, whether as a decision-maker or observer, is permitted to use Social Media or mobile devices during an 'exempt' session or disclose in any way the content of the items under discussion.

The Chair of the meeting has the discretion to terminate or suspend filming or recordings.

Recording of children and vulnerable adults can only take place with the express consent of a responsible adult.

Members of the public who object to being filmed or photographed may move to an area designated by the Council. Individuals choosing to sit in a designated area are reminded that panoramic views taken may inevitable include a designated area and that individuals are free to film, record or photograph members of the public who participate in discussions whether sitting in a designated area or not.
