1	<b>Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 27th June 2017</b> Minutes confirmed as an accurate record of our meeting	
2	<p><b>Welcome to Maria Dunn, Worcester City Planning Officer</b></p> <p>Maria presented a slide show titled 'What is a Neighbourhood Plan?'. Her slides have been put on Slack. Principally it is a community-led planning document with vision, aims, planning policies and site allocations. It includes social, economic and environment issues. The community decides its scope, focus and duration and forms part of the statutory development plan for the area. The plan must meet basic conditions and contribute to the achievement of sustainable development with appropriate regard to national policy and in general with existing strategic local planning policy. These are tested by an examiner and approved by the City Council. The evidence base must be proportionate and robust with general conformity with the local plan.</p> <p>We have the authorised designation from the City Council to proceed and we are now in the evidence gathering stage. All public engagement must be documented and ongoing, keeping a record of all feedback received, and must include those living, working, or doing business in the Plan area. This should encompass different consultation methods to ensure we include as many people and businesses as possible. However, only those residing in the area will have a right to vote for or against the Neighbourhood Plan.</p> <p>Under the City Council's duty to support, Maria is keen to keep in touch as we advance, and would like to see our project plan timetable with key milestones. She will also comment on drafts and advise as we move forward. Her top tips:</p> <p>Set a realistic timetable, focus on the issues we want to address, think about the basic conditions as we go through the process, document all consultation. The whole process will take around 18 months.</p> <p>After discussing the process in detail (please see the slides on Slack), Maria took questions from the group. The Chairman then thanked her for taking the time to talk openly with us.</p>
