We thank Angie and Tony for re-opening the shop and wish them every success. Due to the high cost and lack of flexibility by PO they have decided not to open a PO but will endeavor to provide some of the services that a PO would have provided. This has been a hard decision for them but they are running a business and the contract the PO were offering were not beneficial to a small business.

# PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATOR SEE ATTACHED INFORMATION CARDS

**ALWAYS DIAL 999 for advice in an emergency** Training equipment has been obtained at no cost from British Heart Foundation (BHF) and this will be used at future sessions.

**Bayton Common BT Box** – It was agreed last year to put a Defib Machine in this box. An application was made to BHF but the funding ran out so the application was not successful. A further application will be made when funds are available.

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## Finances at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016

Our new year starts on 1<sup>st</sup> April. A balance of **£16548.24** was carried over from last year.

#### **RESERVED FUNDS** – for defined projects

£2423.74 is held for Defib costs. This money cannot be spent on any other projects.

Following requests by residents it was agreed to look into extending the wall at Coronation Corner, Bayton, funds are being reserved for that, so far we have £1060.00 held. We have set money aside for costs that may happen such as extra audit fees, repairs to seats/bins, work on trees, election fees, rock salt for parish bins and staff sickness, this amounts to £6883.74. Another £6000.00 has been set aside for the unexpected, total reserves held are £12883.74.

### GRANTS

Last year a grant of £50.00 was paid to help with the Clows Top Pantomime costs.

On 12<sup>th</sup> April 2016 a grant of £200.00 was paid to Bayton Village Hall Committee for the maintenance of Bayton Recreation Ground and Bayton Church received £360.00 towards the mowing costs of Bayton Church yard. Both grants are to fund work through to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017. Grant application forms are available from the Clerk or website.

The precept requested for 2016-17 is **£7600.00**, an increase of £250.00.

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#### Planning

**Clows Top crossroads** – This application still needs approval for sewerage system.

**General Planning** – If you have concerns regarding building work being undertaken please let Clerk/Cllr know. All queries will be treated as confidential.

#### HIGHWAYS

Bayton to Mamble Road – Severn Trent will be doing further work within the Parish in JULY 2016, details will be posted on Noticeboards/Website. Potholes – Report to Clerk or WCC via website. We are working with WCC to ensure work is done on Meadow Farm, Beach Hay and Nineveh Roads.

#### Seat – Colliers Hill

Thanks must go to the residents who quickly repaired the seat, at no cost to the Parish. The damage was reported to the Police but no suspects have been detained

Figures showed this site was not being viewed very much. A request was made in the last Newsletter for offers to maintain the site but no one volunteered. The Parish Council therefore agreed to close the site.

**Broadband** - BT Superfast Broadband has been installed at Clows Top exchange. Residents not living in Clows Top will have to register an interest to have this service as it is demand led.

**Dog issues** – Please pick up litter/dog mess to help keep the Parish tidy. Complaints concerning dog mess continue to be made. Dog owners are also reminded that a barking dog is a nuisance to neighbours especially if it is left in the garden. If you are not there you will not hear it. Dogs bark for a reason. Residents should keep a diary of noise issues and report to Worcester Regulatory Services on 01905 822799.
