The minutes of Childswickham Parish Council Meeting held at The Memorial Hall, Childswickham on Thursday 24th April 2014.

1. Apologies for Absence.

- The clerk will place on the website, AED position and instructions for its use.
- The Council awarded funding to the village news to enable the advertisement of the AED and the neighbourhood watch.

Clerk to write to Seven Trent and the Environment Agency regarding its concerns of the siting of more static homes at Leadons Park and their impact on the environment, especially foul and rain water, nothing appears to have changed since the council voiced its concerns in 2008.
