MINUTES:

Minutes of the Meeting held on 8th December 2014 were circulated, approved and signed.

Cllr Keith Wright-Maple Tree-The Cross- Equipment supplier.

OPEN FORUM ITEMS.

- Bretforton School consultation to parents to consider expanding school to take year 6 pupils. The earliest that this can be put into place is September 2016.
- Official opening of Bretforton Community Shop on Saturday 13th December 2014.

PROGRESS REPORTS FOR INFORMATION.

Clerk:

- Precept- It was unanimously agreed to apply for precept of 1.8% increase. Proposed by Cllr Wright. Seconded by Cllr Hall. The total amount will be £25090
- Clerk confirmed that pay had been adjusted by £211.50 gross.

Chairman;

- Letter from Bretfest was read out thanking PC for donation to project.
- Letter read out regarding an incident concerning state of Sports Club car park. Chair has responded on PC behalf. Item dealt with in item 7.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION.

- 1. **Allotments- Land-** Meeting has taken place where it was agreed to apply for map to show landowners around Bretforton and identify all land. Chair will provide a map so that Cllr grant can apply for information required. Costs will be provided for next meeting. Chair has been approached by landowner who may possibly have land available. Sub-committee to make contact. Next agenda.
- 2. **Street Lighting-i.The Cross**. It was unanimously agreed that given the costs provided by WPD and that permission would need to be obtained from National Trust for use of power supply, that PC would not continue with this project. However, it was agreed that light outside school field should be upgraded. Ii. British legion. It was unanimously agreed to request Eon to replace light at a cost of £394 plus VAT. Proposed by 7 Cllr Cleveland. Seconded by Cllr Wright. Chair will look into solar powered lights for next meeting.
- 3. **Visibility at B4035/Main Street Junction.-** Clerk has met with Highways who have confirmed that in their opinion visibility on junction of Main Street and B4035 is not impaired. The cutting back of vegetation is a nice to but is not required. They confirmed that there has never been any reported incidents, complaints or accidents reported at this junction.
- 4. **Acquisition of Theatre Barn-** Clerk has contacted Theatre Barn to check position.
- 5. **Maple Tree-The Cross.** Following the report produced from BJ Unwin's visit, it was unanimously agreed that the report should be followed exactly. Therefore the tree will be removed and planted will be carried out. Sally Griffiths will be contacted to confirm her agreement and then Arborvale, R H Small, Harvington and Ancient Oaks asked to quote for the works. Both will receive the report. Wood should be given to Bretforton School for any project that they wish. Proposed by Cllr Hall. Seconded by Cllr Grant. All in favour, 1 abstention. Send letter to property owner.
- **6.** Village defib- Cllr Wright has seen a presentation by West Midlands Ambulance Service who have 80 defib devices free. Clerk to email them and ask for a device and free training. A case will need to be purchased. Location will be considered once device has been secured but suggestions are- Community Shop, Sports Club or village hall. There will be an annual service charge of £99. Proposed by Cllr Grant. Seconded by Cllr Carter. All in favour.
- **7. Bretforton Sports Club-i. Height barrier-** It was agreed to defer until next meeting to assess car park state and vehicles using car park such as PO van.

Ii. Lease & Licence- Funds have not been received for proportion of legal fees to renew lease and licence nor the monthly standing order due to commence on 1st November 2015 as per lease. It was unanimously agreed to send formal letter given 30 days for payment ending on 12th February 2015 at noon before legal advice is sort. Advice that this is a breach of lease and licence and thus is void and that interest on outstanding amount will be charged. Proposed by Cllr Wright. Seconded by Cllr Grant. All

in favour.

Iii. **Car Park-** Concerns have been raised by residents and Sports Club with regard to the new car park surface. Chair and Clerk have met with contractor to assess car park. They have advised that although state of car park is not ideal it will dry out and harden. They are regularly monitoring the state and will carry out any remedial work required. They have put mats outside club door to catch any mess brought up path. At the time of visit, there was no obvious mess on path.

- **8. Publication of Minutes-** It was unanimously agreed that minutes would be posted on noticeboard when they have been approved at following meeting to ensure that all residents have access to the information. Proposed by Cllr Wright. Seconded by Cllr Grant. All in favour.
- 9. Burial Fees- Following investigation of fees at Evesham Cemeteries, it was unanimously agreed to increase some fees with immediate effect. A copy will be put on BG noticeboard and one other and all funeral directors advised. Gravediggers fees will increase to £290 for burial and £50 for ashes and admin fee will increase to £50. Proposed by Cllr Wright. Seconded by Cllr Grant. All in favour.
