# 5 FINANCE and GENERAL PURPOSES

- 5.1 Payment of the attached Bills was approve
- 5.2 Cllr P Harvey explained the main variances from last year's accounts, largely greater expenditure due to the purchase of the additional Speed Indicator Sign, the defibrillators, higher lengthsman costs & the work on Blackwell Road. It was agreed that a new category 'Health and Wellbeing' be introduced on the Annual Summary to include the expense of the defibrillators as there was no logical place for it to be within the existing categories. Cllr Forknell requested an explanation relating to the overspend on Highways Emergency which was due to the work on Blackwell Road footway as well as the new Speeding Indicator sign. There were no other comments and the draft figures were approved

- 5.3 The 'LICKEY POETRY FESTIVAL' will take place on 23rd-25th October at Hillscourt & other Lickey venues. John McQuaid, organizer and Cofton Hackett councillor has had much experience at the Ledbury festival. He has income generating ideas with programme advertising and merchandise but does need funds and volunteers especially in the first year.
- Cllr P Harvey proposed and initial grant of £200 which was unanimously agreed 5.4 It was agreed that we would not make an application through the New Homes Bonus Community Grants Scheme as we had not been affected by any large development.

- 6.1 The Planning Committee minutes were approved.
- 6.2 The next Working Group of the Marlbrook Tip will be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> April. Cllr J Harvey is not able to attend but Cllr King volunteered to attend
- 6.3 Cllr J Harvey reported on the highly informative Historic Environment Workshop for Neighbourhood Planning and Cllr King suggested that we now hold a residents meeting on the subject so that more residents could become involved
- 6.4 Cllr J Harvey reported on the meeting with Barnt Green Waters and other stakeholders to discuss the Greenbelt review in relation to the land around the reservoirs. The area is an SSSI and if the Greenbelt review took away protection there is a concern that flooding issues could arise

- 7.1 The replacement signage and speed monitoring currently in place on Rose Hill was noted. No resurfacing has taken place as yet. We still await instruction from WCC as to where we should locate the new speed sign.
- 7.2 The request from High House Wood Management Team has been withdrawn.
