## 369/14 Minutes of previous meeting

#### 370/14 Farmland Walks

The Committee noted that the farm walk had been undertaken on the 8<sup>th</sup> October over the Wildmoor land. A further walk would be arranged before the end of the year to visit the Stoneybridge farms. The Committee agreed to hold the 2016 farm walks shortly prior to the next Committee meeting which would be summoned for 18<sup>th</sup> July 2016. ### 371/14 Land Security

## 372/14 Any other Agricultural Holdings items

Cllr. Hood advised that the track between the holdings at Stoneybridge farm should be assessed for possible improvements due to damage caused by heavy farm vehicles.

Action: The proposed farm walk by due by 31/12/2016 to assess.

Cllr. Margetts requested that digitalised maps are produced to more easily differentiate the holdings.

Action: the clerk to arrange to purchase maps.

Cllr. Margetts requested that a future agenda should consider the adoption of an ethical farming policy and that the tenants could be asked to adhere to such policy if adopted.
