PARISH PATHWAYS PARTNERSHIP SCHEME 2017/2018: It was decided that the same footpaths that were included on the application form last year, should be included on the application form for 2017/2018. - 10. BROCKHILL LANE: Bromsgrove DC can arrange for CCTV camera to be installed but if there is no activity, it will be taken down. Cllr Tolley stated that there is still rubbish being dumped. The Chairman asked Cllr Whittaker if he could speak to Bromsgrove DC to put a CCTV camera up for a few weeks. Cllr Whittaker to enquire.
