Cllr Baker addressed the meeting on the subject of paved gardens. He pointed out that there were a large number of front gardens in the parish that have been surfaced, most but not all to accommodate the parking of cars. His main concern was environmental and the affects on flooding in particular. He felt that, given that such work in most cases requires planning permission, there was a need for more control. Cllr Baker concluded that further action is needed and suggested that the views of other parish councils be sought, perhaps through CALC.

Cllr Baker left the meeting at 19.45

The Chairman proposed and it was agreed by the meeting that the subject of paved gardens in agenda item 7 be considered at this point.

Paved gardens

The Assistant Clerk summarised the legislative context and the policy position of Bromsgrove District Council. The issue was discussed during which it was considered that there was a need for more people to be aware of the relevant legislation and the availability of free guidance on the Government's website. Also, given that the underlying rationale for the legislation was the prevention of flooding, that there could be serious implications from the continued surfacing of front gardens in impermeable material. Concern was also expressed about the number of blocked drains in the parish.

It was agreed that:

- When commenting on planning applications for new residential development such comment should include the requirement that front gardens not be surfaced in impermeable material
- The concern of Planning Committee on this issue be included in the Neighbourhood Plan
- The concern of Planning Committee on this issue be raised at the next meeting of the County Association of Local Councils.
- The Assistant Clerk arranges for reference to this issue to be included on the Parish Council's website including a link to the Government's guidance document
- The Assistant Clerk submits a brief entry in the next edition of the Parish Magazine on this matter including the above mentioned link and in particular drawing the readers attention to the flooding implications
- The issue of blocked drains be considered at the next meeting of the Environment and Highways Committee on 8th March 2018
