Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 10th July 2023 in West Malvern Village Hall at 7:30pm.

83/23 Public participation

The Council invites local residents attending the meeting to make comments and suggestions, and question the Parish Council on issues on the agenda, or raise issues for future consideration: No matters were discussed.

84/23 Apologies

To consider acceptance of apologies for absence from Councillors: Cllr. Mr S Sanoon(accepted).

85/23 Interests

i. Councillors Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPI) and Other Disclosable Interests (ODI) regarding items on the agenda: Cllr. Turner declared a ODI on agenda item 11i (Finance) considering a grant to the local Primary School since his wife was on the Governing Body. ii. Notification of changes to the register of interests: There were none.

iii. To consider written requests from councillors for the council to grant a dispensation for those with Disclosable Interests to take part in discussions or voting: Cllr. Turner was granted a dispensation to discuss but not to vote on agenda item 11i, considering a grant to the local Primary School. This would last until the next ordinary election.

86/23 Reports from other representatives

To receive reports from County and District Councillors, and other representatives:

Mr Charles Penn (Malvern Hills Trust) reported that there would be elections for new trustees in October and that recent boundary commission ward changes were causing some charging issues. The Trust was working towards a 74 provision so that they could spend funds on changing the constitution. He also confirmed that ash dieback was not as prevalent as first expected.

District & County Clir. Natalie McVey reported that she was looking at ways to stop newly installed attract lights on Lord Park from chining directly into proportion. There was also an insure with

street lights on Lamb Bank from shining directly into properties. There was also an issue with 'excessive' strimming in this area. She confirmed that the newly elected District Council had started to hold meetings and planning meetings were to start this month. Finally she reported on two planned road closures of West Malvern Road.

District Cllr. Prof. John Raine had nothing to add Cllr. McVeys report.
