- e Charity donation to Lindridge School. Cllr Mapp advised that since COVID, resources in all departments are stretched due to lack of fundraising projects. It was proposed by D Hubbard, seconded by R Lear to donate £200 towards general school finds. All agreed.

- e Drains require jetting outside The Forge reported, they have also been marked. It was suggested that local maps would be useful for identifying problem drains/gullies.
- f Overgrown hedges in Jewkes Lane landowner is still being pursued by Highways the first of two letters are to be sent to the landowner.
