Possible Sale of the Village Hall

a) Consider the five offers to purchase the Village Hall submitted to Herbert Banks Estate Agents. Details circulated in advance - and decide to proceed with the sale.

Opening the discussion the chairman Cllr B Munt said it was important that the council as trustee of the Village Hall take into account the future use that may be made of the hall when considering a sale.

After a comprehensive discussion it was agreed that the difference between the highest bid with the possibility of retaining some parish use and the outright highest offer (£11.526 difference) was too much to allow the council to consider accepting the lower offer.

The council agreed to accept the highest offer of £46.526 and asked the clerk to inform the estate agent accordingly.

b) Consider any additional conditions regarding a sale (if agreed). Note circulated in advance

It was decided not to apply any additional conditions to the sale as any long-term claw-back conditions attached to the sale would not result in a significant profit for the council.

c) Instruct the Clerk to the Council to proceed with details of the sale.
