Q8 If you have selected Nursery, Pre-school or Primary School, A to C above, do you attend the village schools?





Q10 Which services have members of your household used in Powick & Callow End in the last 24 months? (please tick all that apply)







Q14 Do you know how to contact your Parish Council?





Q16 How do you find out about what is going on locally? (please tick all that apply)







Q47 If YES, how frequently have people in your household used the local bus service prior to Covid 19 restrictions?




