You will be aware that there is a traditional red telephone box in High Green that is no longer operational and has now fallen into a sad state of deterioration.

- Your Parish Council has been offered the option of buying the phone box from BT for a nominal amount (£1), along with the associated future commitment of maintaining it as a grade two listed asset<sup>1</sup>. Telephone boxes have been retained in similar circumstances elsewhere and reused in a number of ways eg. mini-libraries, information points, sale of local produce and first aid stations. Others have been lost to their communities and we want to know whether this matters to you.
- Before making a decision on whether to purchase the telephone box we would welcome your views, as a resident, as to whether it would be worthwhile?
- If it was adopted by the parish council, how might it best be used?

A recent repair to another phone box in Grimley in a similar condition cost around £300 to strip, repaint and repair, with labour conducted by volunteers. Annual budget for spare glass and replacement light bulbs might be in region of £50. BT would continue to pick up the cost of powering the internal light after adoption.
