DEFIBRILLATOR MACHINE

West Midlands Ambulance (WMAS) has advised us that due to the closure of Ambulance Stations response times to 999 calls could be longer, especially in rural areas. WMAS would like to see a Defib. machine located in rural parishes to ensure the best care is given locally as quickly as possible. If your heart stops for any reason a Defib. machine could restart it. The machine will be accessible to anyone to use. Training will be given by WMAS but is not essential as the machine tells you what to do. The Parish Council will help to provide funding for machines to be located in Bayton and Clows Top. The Parish Council will look for grants, provide insurance cover and oversee the necessary weekly checks to ensure the machine is usable.

A group of Bayton Residents have agreed to help raise funds for these machines. The Christmas Lunch Team has given £200.00 and our County Cllr has granted £500.00. The machines are approximately £1500.00 each plus installation. This includes the box needed to store them in. Machines would be located on the outside of a building yet to be decided. If you would like to donate or have fundraising ideas please contact the Clerk a Councillor or Keith Weller (832816). Cheques should be made payable to Bayton Parish Council with Defib. machine written on the back. If you prefer to make a transfer online please contact Clerk for details. All money raised/donated will be placed in the Parish Council Bank Account marked as Reserved Funds for purchase of Defib. machines and cannot be used for any other purposes.
