22/01432 – Sumach, Priory Road – To consider new Landscape Management Plan and a Proposed Landscaping Plan recently submitted to Bromsgrove District Council Despite the submission of the Landscaping Plan the Parish Council still stands by its original comments, and remain concerned as to the structure, quality, and safety of the infill, which is a significant amount, as noted by the Conservation Officer, as it runs the entire length of the property, and drops over 10m height. Despite the proposals the Parish Council firmly believes that the change to the landscape harms the significance of the Conservation Areas as a Designated Heritage Asset, as well as harming the setting of Sumach, a Non-Designated Heritage Asset. The Parish Council also disagree with a three-acre area of field with which the property sits in being accepted as curtilage.
