Clerk: Details of the windfarm seminars to be circulated. The Clerk's report was Noted.

Chairman: Expressed his concern that the prison shop might close, as there was very little produce available. Cllr Pengelly understood the shop was being market tested, as resources were limited. To be discussed at the next meeting.

Police: CSO J Tilt's emailed report was noted.

District Councillor: Nothing significant to report

County Councillor: The continuous flashing height warning light on Hewell Lane had been reported to Highways. Richard Clewer is now the Highway's contact for this area. The County Cllr was thanked for organising the marker posts etc to the Community Hall entrance.

Footpath Warden: Had been covered in Annual Report and submitted as a written report.

Tree Warden: New Wharf: residents had sent a letter to British Waterways concerned about their new tenant wanting to take down a couple of trees.

Tutnall Close: The Warden had spoken to the Redditch BC Tree Warden who agreed to inspect the large yews.

Community Hall: The last payment for the loan would be made this month. The Committee were looking to update the kitchen. Car Boot Sale would be held on 2 July.

Weddings: There had been some problems with car parking at a recent wedding. In future, the churchyard would be closed to vehicles in the evening and directed to the Community Hall car park. The Hall would be requesting their own postcode to avoid cars and taxis turning up at the church late at night. Someone would be employed to close the hall up after functions.

Charities Representative: Had not met.

Conservation Officer: Had contacted British Waterways about trees on New Wharf and other matters.

8 CORRESPONDENCE:

All other items received were tabled in a folder for Councillors' inspection at the meeting and were noted.

9 PLANNING MATTERS:

Applications:

11/0248 Hewell Grange Social Club, The Park: Proposed converstion of existing former social club into 3 residential dwellings.

Resolved: To comment there were no objections to the application.

Approvals: None received.

Planning Matters: 10/1191 Owl Barn, Tack Farm: Erection of timber garden shed / store - Appeal dismissed.

10 LENGTHSMAN SCHEME: The Lengthsman to be asked to clear a sign of vegetation at the Vigo and side-out in Tutnall Close.

11 HIGHWAYS MATTERS:

Road noise to A448: agreed to await outcome of current highways investigation. Review of speed limit B4096: There were no objections to Highway's proposals.

- 12 COMMUNITY PAYBACK SCHEME: There were a number of gueries contained in the report prepared by West Mercia Probation Trust for the bollard installation at The Orchard, Alcester Road. However, it was agreed that someone from the Parish Council would be in attendance at the start of the project. The 6inch diameter posts should be installed at 5ft centres.
- 13 **COMMUNITY RESILIENCE:** The document contained six schedules with details for various contacts. The clerk had amalgamated the schedules into one and this would be circulated with next month's agenda so Members could recommend additional items.
- 14 RAILINGS TO PLYMOUTH MEMORIAL: Cllr Pengelly offered to contact the Hereford & Worcester Gardener's Trust working with prison charities / The Hewell Grange Restoration Group to request advice and financial assistance in replacing the railings.
- 15 NEW PATH TO FRONT ENTRANCE OF COMMUNITY HALL: In order to move matters forward it was agreed a meeting would be held on 26 May with R Oldaker and J Hillier, representing the Community Hall, and Cllrs Whitehouse and Denyer and the Clerk representing the Parish Council.
- 16 RISK ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE: Approved.

17 CORE STRATEGY HOUSING PROPOSALS: It was noted that the large scale housing proposals are not likely to proceed in the foreseeable future.
