7. <u>To review planning log and provide comment / update including Local Planning Authority decisions, appeals, enforcement actions and outstanding queries.</u>

The planning log was reviewed; members noted recent Planning Authority decisions relating to Log Numbers 680, 681, 682, 683, 684 and 685 which had all been approved. The Clerk also drew Members attention to two enforcements that had recently been closed in Catshill in relation to:

306A Stourbridge Road – 2016/0115/ENF – Converted Garage to Living Accommodation

Discretionary powers had been exercised taking into regard the scale of the extension, the impact on the street scene, parking matters and residential amenity including privacy issues and how the enforcement function of the District Council operates in the wider public interest. This led to the enforcement being closed.

19 Woodrow Close – 2016/0116/ENF – Owner gated off path to rear within a shared pathway

This walkway was not owned by the District Council and is not an official Right of Way and therefore it is a Civil Matter that should be dealt with by a Solicitor. This led to the enforcement being closed. Members engaged in discussion relating to the enforcements and the use of discretionary powers. Outstanding issues were noted as the Enforcement Officers actioning issues with signage within the Village as per meeting held 08/09/16 with Matthew Austin and Paul Hurlstone from Bromsgrove District Council.

The Clerk informed the Council that it seemed most beneficial for Planning Committees to be spaced at monthly intervals as accurately as possible to allow for extension requests on Comments to be within the date that Planning Officers could accommodate.
