6.1 Apologies: Mr ANC Champion, Mrs R Kirby and District Councillor Farmer.

6.2 Declaration of Interest: Item 5.9 Cllr Hart (Chairman of the Village Hall Management Committee).

6.3 Minutes: The minutes for 10th January 2012 were approved as a true record and signed.

6.4 Highways and Lengthsman: The temporary traffic regulation notices in future to be notified by email was noted. There was no Lengthsman's Report.

6.5 County Councillor's Report: Dr Pollock reported that the work on Teme Bridge is now complete and it is hoped that town trade will now increase. Major drainage and road works are planned for Tenbury next year.
Dr Pollock agreed to look into the following.
The school bus stop at Stanford Bridge. PC to inform him of numbers involved.
Road markings outside The Bridge and Gate Cottage, white line has eroded.
Clifton Hill/Ham Bridge, the removal of trees has only partially improved visibility.
Grit Bins, they have still not been reinstated.
Refuse bags falling on to the highway and creating a nuisance will be referred to District Councillor Farmer.

6.6 Planning: Appeal notification 11/01242/HOU and 11/01243/LBC at Southwood Farm. No comment was submitted as there was no comment on the original application.

6.7 Clerk's report on urgent decisions. A Cheque for £354.00 was sent to Harrison Clark to conclude the transfer and entry onto the land registry.

After attending a meeting with other parishes it was considered that what was being offered was not relevant to this parish and the matter will not be pursued, however a member of the Martley Mesh team will be invited to the Annual Parish Meeting to discuss the potential expansion of this scheme for The Shelsleys residents.
