a) Events Working Group

i. Remembrance Day Service

- The Clerk should obtain contact details of all present at the time of the laying of the three aforementioned wreaths and retain those details for a minimum of 21 days.
- Other parties may lay a wreath at any time other than the times pre agreed with the Clerk providing they adhere to all Covid guidelines.
- The Clerk should publicise the decision of Council through the District Council and the Malvern Gazette and on the Parish Notice Boards.

ii. Sing a Song of Christmas

To cancel Sing A Song Of Christmas for December 2020.

Note 1: If guidelines change to the extent that some form of carol singing celebration is able to take place then the organisers are prepared to try and arrange a suitable event at the last minute.

Note 2: <u>Christmas Hall Decorating 2020</u> will therefore also not take place. A date in early December 2021 for Christmas hall decorating will be announced in early 2021.

Sing a Song of Christmas 2021 will be planned for the second Friday in December, 10th December 2021

iii. Fete

To agree the date for the fete in 2021 to be held on the second Sunday in September that being Sunday 12th September 2021.
