8. Confirm the adoption the General Power of Competence

This Council declares that it meets the criteria set by the Secretary of State under the Localism Act 2011 (s8) in the Parish Councils (General Power of Competence) (Prescribed Conditions) Order 2012. viz:

i. At least two-thirds of total number of councillors must have been elected

ii. The Clerk holds CiLCA 2012 or other relevant qualification.

And therefore confirms the adoption of the General Power of Competence as set out in the above act.

9. Sports Facilities on the Council Playing Field.

The council has over the years provided a 'cricket practice facility' in the form of cricket nets with an appropriate playing surface and has been advised that these are in need of substantial repair and are dangerous to use. The estimated cost to bring this facility back to full use is c£4000

The committee of the Alfrick and Lulsley Cricket Club suggest that a portable playing surface mat and demountable nets would be a preferable option and would also release the corner of the field for a Children's Play Area.

Alfrick and Lulsley Cricket Club is prepared to store this proposed equipment and make it available on request to other cricketers.

It is proposed that the council purchases a portable playing surface mat and demountable nets at a cost of £3344 ex vat.
