

Contractors sought for Refurbishment of the Suckley Playing Fields Pavillion

Suckley Parish Council is planning to refurbish the existing pavilion on its playing fields. It is currently largely used to provide changing facilities for the 11 a-side football pitch which is used during the football season. The Parish Council has recognised that there is a need to upgrade the existing facilities, but also wants to create an enhanced community space that can be used for meetings, parties and other social events. As such the Parish Council is looking for contractors who can provide a turnkey solution for some internal carpentry including doors and kitchen cabinets, installation of electrical fittings and constructing a new lead to disabled toilet cubicle

.The Council has applied for a grant to fund this project and has been promised a conditional response to this by 17 September. Following this, the Council will be required to supply further details before the grant will be approved. In any case, contracts would have to be in place and the work started by 31 March 2026. In view of this, contractors may prefer to submit expressions of interest for the work at this. Should the bid be successful, then required works would comprise:

Carpentry – Doors, shower divider
Kitchen – Cabinets, Sink
Electrical – Hand dryer, extractor fan, infra-red heater
Fire Safety – Smoke & Fire Alarm, Fire Signage
External – New Toilet with lighting, hand dryer, basin
Plumbing and drainage

The site containing the pavilion at the playing fields, Suckley. Access to is restricted only by a narrow roadway at the end of Church Lane, Suckley WR6 5DE.
