

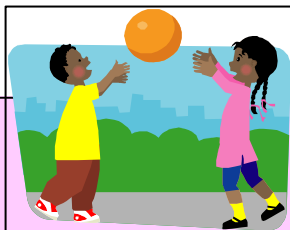


Chaddesley amateur theatrical society stages two productions in the Village Hall each year. Rehearsals are held twice a week during the run up to a show. Membership is for aged 14

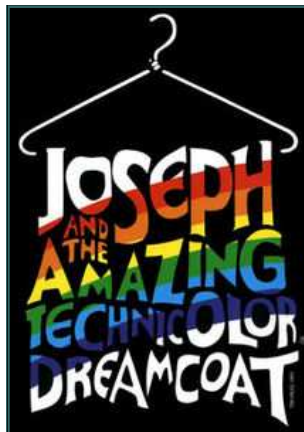
