#### Precept for 2011 - 2012

The Parish Council are pleased to announce that they have been able to set our precept at the same level as last year which is good news for everyone as it assists in keeping down the cost of your Council Tax Bill. We are also pleased that a further 10% payment in Grant Aid has been agreed by Wyre Forest District Council.

#### **Churchyard Grant**

The Parish Council will also be applying for a Churchyard Grant in the sum of £720 which will go towards maintenance of the churchyard.

#### Crime

Although crime levels remain low, in the event of repeated bad weather, everyone is advised to take caution, it is not advisable to leave vehicles unattended with the keys in and the engine running in an attempt to warm up and defrost the windows. This opportunity has proved to be too tempting to opportunist thieves across the country!

#### Winter Weather

Without doubt, the heavy snow and ice we have been experiencing has taken it's toll on the roads and the Parish Council will endeavor to oversee that areas of the roads with potholes causing a problem to motorists, will be reported to the County Council and we will follow up any complaint to ensure that any necessary work is undertaken. Please report any highway complaints either to myself or direct to the Worcestershire Hub.

Concerns have been expressed about the lack of Grit Bins and gritting of the roads. The Parish Council are doing all they can to improve the situation for everyone although the low stock of rock salt and provision of Grit Bins is a wide spread problem particularly on minor routes.

#### **New Councillor**

Following the resignation of Mark Stinton, Richard Wignall has been co-opted on to the Council as his replacement. Richard is already actively involved with Neighbourhood Watch in Stanklyn Lane, and it is hoped that this will now be extended to cover other areas of the parish.
