- VACANCIES PIRTON WARD & DRAKES BROUGHTON WARD-There are vacancies on the Parish Council for members to represent Pirton ward & Drakes Broughton ward. Please contact the clerk for more information. Anyone interested is welcome come along to observe a meeting to see what is involved.
- PIRTON POLLING STATION The Parish Council are working hard to get the polling station in Pirton reinstated after it was removed without proper consultation.
- WALCOT FORD The Parish Council is working with County Councillor Linda Robinson to try and get some changes to the warning signage/barriers to prevent drivers entering the water when in flood.

- OPEN SPACE PHASE 2 The Parish Council are in the process of finalising what is to be included in phase 2 of the Open Space Development in Drakes Broughton. If you would like to be involved in making the changes happen, please get in touch – we really do need some additional help!
- PLAYPARK LITTER The Parish Council wish to remind users to please place litter in the bins provided, with nicer weather the Play Park will become busier let's keep it clean and tidy for all.
- VANDALISM ON PLAYING FIELD It is disappointing to have to report that again during the
 month another one of the signs at the Playing Field was knocked down and damaged. The
 Parish Council remind anyone who witnesses vandalism or anti-social behaviour on the
 playing field to report it to 101. If things are not reported no one knows there are
 problems and so no action is taken.
- COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE The Community Bus service has funding to continue until
 December, this is a demand lead, door to door service to replace bus services lost over the
 years. The more the service is used the more likely it will be retained into the future.
