Welcome to the Hill and Moor newsletter for Spring 2019. In the past three months we have set a budget for 2019/20 and set the Parish Council's part of your Council Tax. This has resulting in a slight decrease for residents on the Parish level of Council Tax.

We have also completed work on the path lighting from the car park to the field entrance opposite the Village Hall and installed a memorial bench commemorating the end of "The Great War".

Funds for a basket swing and timber trail plus improvements to the existing play area surface have now been approved by Wychavon. An order has been placed for the work and we have been advised that the work will probably be in 6 to 8 weeks time and will take 2 to 3 weeks; this would take us to the latter part of May.

We have some funds remaining from "New Homes Bonus" and are currently hoping to submit a bid for funds towards the cost of a proposed refurbishment of the kitchen in the Village Hall and the installation of audio visual equipment for presentations and films etc. in the Hall.

A bid is also being submitted for improvements/ refurbishment of the football pitch. The funding stream that is applicable to this project is Section 106 monies specifically for outdoor pitches.

Finally, can I bring to your attention the Annual Parish Meeting which is to be held at 7pm on Thursday 25th April in the Village Hall. This meeting is an opportunity for residents to come along and hear about the work of the Parish Council, to meet the Parish Councillors and our County and District Councillor, Liz Tucker and to ask any questions you may have. We also hope to have brief reports from a representative of the Village Hall committee, Women's Institute and the Church.

### Parish Council Elections 2019

Every four years the current Parish Councillors' term of office comes to an end and local elections are held to elect or re-elect councillors to serve their local area.

This year, there are elections for Parish Councillors and District Councillors and the poll takes place on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May**. The polling station for Hill and Moor Parish is the Lower Moor Village Hall as usual and you can vote betweeen 7am and 10pm. Polling cards for everyone on the Electoral Register will arrive in the post and you can apply for a postal vote if you wish – get your application for a postal vote in by the 15<sup>th</sup> April.

If you are not on the Electoral Register, or aren't sure, please contact Wychavon on 01386 565000. You will need to be registered by the 12<sup>th</sup> April at the latest if you want to vote in the 2019 elections.

# If you would like to be a Councillor on the Parish Council...

...you can get a form from the Parish Clerk or from Wychavon District Council, who administer all the local elections. You will need someone from the parish to nominate you on the form and also someone to 'second' the nomination. These individuals will also need to be on the Electoral Register to be able to do this.

#### Do you have time for a walk?

A volunteer opportunity exists in your local parish – to contribute towards the accessibility, maintenance and improvement of your local public rights of way network for the benefit of the local and wider community.

Worcestershire County Council, in partnership with Hill and Moor Parish Council, is looking for a **Parish Paths Warden**.

The role will involve regular inspections and a practical approach to the minor maintenance of footpaths and bridleways in the area on behalf of the Public Rights of Way team at Worcestershire County Council. A reasonable level of fitness and basic map reading skills are required.

A positive, but diplomatic approach to the role is essential, it may not likely that you will achieve miracles but it IS possible for you to make a real difference by making small changes or carrying out repairs and at the same time you may even discover less-known routes right on your doorstep!

Some knowledge of the local area would be beneficial but not essential.

Regular support from a designated Public Rights of Way Officer is available to assist you in this role. Full training is provided and the reimbursement of any expenses incurred whilst carrying out this role offered.
