### Climate crisis

A COUNCIL has declared a climate emergency, saying there are only 12 years left to take action.

Grimley Parish Council passed the motion to take what action it can to combat climate emergency.

The plan includes "A significant and ongoing reduction in the use of energy in buildings, transport, food, and consumption" as well as "The regeneration and rebuilding of our natural ecosystems" and "Promote and support adaptation measures to reduce the risks to our community arising from Climate Change."

A council spokesman said: "Our emergency declaration is an opportunity to create a better and sustainable future for ourselves and our children, that will enhance our community, environment, local economy and our overall well-being."

Several local authorities, including Malvern Hills District Council, have already declared a climate emergency.
