VACANCY FOR ONE COUNCILLOR

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 87(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 that G.Green, formerly a Member of the above Parish Council, has ceased to be a Member at his own request and that consequently ONE casual vacancy exist in the office of Councillor for the said Parish.
