### COMMUNITY SHOP STEERING GROUP

Thank you to everyone who filled in their survey. We sent out approximately 400 surveys and had a 40% return. The information given showed overwhelming support for a Shop with PO. The group have looked at other areas with Community Shops. The Group have met the PO and know the options that may be available to them. We are in contact with the Plunkett Foundation who give advice about Community Shops and we also have contacted the Planning Officers at Wyre Forest and Malvern Hills. Whatever we do we will need a business plan to apply for grants. We will be having another meeting at Clows Top Village Hall soon so please come and support this project. ### Finances at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015

Our new year starts on  $1^{st}$  April. A balance of £14547.88 was carried over from last year - £2423.74 being Defib Money which can only be spent on matters related to the Defib Machines (see above) - £300.00 our County Cllr gave us and £100.00 our Dist Cllr gave us towards initial costs of looking into the possibility of a Community Shop – £94.00 our Dist Cllr gave us to pass to Bayton Village Hall for fence repairs. We have set money aside for costs that may happen such as extra Audit Fees, repairs to seats/bins, election fees, rock salt for Parish bins etc. and we have set £4000.00 aside for the unexpected, this amounts to £10483.74 of the carried forward figure.

The advice we are given is to have enough money to cover one year's budget. The precept requested for this year is £7500.00, an increase of £500.00. This is to cover any costs that may be needed to look into the possibility of a Community Shop.

Bayton Village Hall Committee did not make any further requests to the Parish Council for grants last year.

The Clerks training amounted to £35.00 for this Parish. As the Clerk works for another Parish the costs have been paid equally. Grants have been received to cover the remaining costs. The training will finish this year.

It will have to be in matching stone, costs to be looked at next year. **Broadband** - BT Superfast Broadband has been installed at Clows Top exchange. Residents not living in Clows Top will have to register an interest to have this service as it is demand led.

### **Bayton Church Car Park Oak Tree**

Dead wood has recently been cut out of the tree, it will be surveyed on a regular basis as advised by our insurance providers.

**Dog issues** – Please pick up litter and dog mess to help keep the Parish tidy. Complaints concerning dog mess continue to be made. Dog owners are also reminded that a barking dog is a nuisance to neighbours especially if it is left in the garden. If you are not there you will not hear it. Dogs bark for a reason.
