The sewage will need to be sorted beforehand. Cllr Wheeler-Vine thinks they will need to adhere to Building Regulations.

Community Hall Representative: The Community Hall is still closed, when the school goes back they still won't need to open. Still taking bookings, not claiming any money from the Government but are alright financially.
