Public Forum

1 resident attended to raise the following questions/comments regarding the land project, she advised that she was speaking on behalf of all Willersey Road residents:

- The comments from residents were within the timescale as detailed on the notice.
- The local residents are disappointed that the PC, Wychavon, County Council and Highways have not taken any notice of the comments raised in relation to flooding in the area or issues with speeding and traffic.
- A request was made for the geo physical survey to be carried out prior to completion of the sale.
- The PC were asked who would have responsibility for the project.
- The PC were asked that if a sub-committee is set up, that a resident from Bowers Hill be included.
- The PC were asked if there would be a resident's meeting.
- Details were given of an incident just before the meeting on Willersey Road where a lorry shed its load onto the verge which could have had serious consequences for pedestrians.

A request has been received to amend the minutes from the July meeting as it is believed that information that reported was incorrect. MiT advised that the minutes are simply a record of what is said at the meeting. It can only be amended if something was said or was not said and this is incorrectly reported. No residents attended the meeting and therefore can't say what was said. The matter refers to a comment that residents of Bowers Hill responded to a planning application after the closing date of 18th June 2020

and require an apology. As a result, the planning officer was contacted and he has apologised by email to the PC as the correct date was 18th June 2020. A planning officer went out on site and displayed a notice with the date on in July. The PC was not advised of this change.

7.	<p>Parish Council-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Land update- PWLB was drawdown on the last available date being 21st August 2020. Contracts were exchanged on 20th August 2020 which was a requirement of the conditional contract because the land would only be purchased if planning approval is achieved. If contracts weren't exchanged prior to determining planning, the value of the land could increase and the diocese would need to explain to charity commission why land was sold at a reduced rate when it had planning permission attached. 4 residents have requested that the geo physical survey be carried out on land prior to completion. However, completion will be 21st September 2020 for the reasons stated above. 2 quotes have been received for survey and 1 approved. They will submit a programme of works to planning officer and archaeological officer and once approved, work will be scheduled for 3 weeks later. Only the BG area requires a survey, however, a survey of the whole site will take place. The PC are confident that all will be well. b. Christmas event- In light of current restrictions, it was suggested by LM that a reduced event take place perhaps, best lit house etc. LM, AW, AT, ID, MT and DW agreed to meet to discuss suggestions. c. A 'cctv policy' was considered and adopted. Councillors considered in a closed session whether to install cctv cameras at village play areas in response to vandalism. 2 quotes have been received. DW proposed that more are obtained. No quote has been received for securing the benches at Badsey rec as the benches can either be secured or have the ability to move them. It was agreed to seek quotes to sink concrete into ground and have chains and locks to secure them.

The size of the original tank was determined by an expert in this field and therefore was agreed as a 5000 litre tank, there would have been reasoning behind this so the original requirement should be maintained. If that amount of rainwater is expected and this size tank required there would be a risk of flooding if the size is reduced. The height of the flood prevention wall is now very low, it should have been put in as 2 feet high. A site visit is required to see that this is not the case. There is also no longer enough space for a 5000 litre tank. We are not experts in this field so would hope that it is properly assessed and resolved by an expert.</p> <p>With regard to condition 8, it is difficult to be able to determine this and would suggest a site visit to establish the detail.</p> <p>Wychavon Decision:</p>

Highways regarding 'village directional' sign- Consideration was given to producing a village map as Highways will not support village directional signage. 	<p>a. Update on scout hut damage-PC have been unable to find a solution to the damage, a quote from Badsey Scouts has been received for consideration but it is too high. GB agreed to get a quote for next meeting for galvanised panel to cover over ends of hut.</p> <p>b. Comments regarding speeding along Willersey Road and other routes- PC were hoping to raise the matter of continued speeding with County Councillor and Police, however they are not in attendance. Clerk has contacted Highways regarding issues and was referred to police who are to carry out speed checks but no date or location has been confirmed. PC are disappointed that more is not being done to deal with speeding by all parties. It was agreed to contact County Councillor, local MP and John Campion, Police Commissioner. Mobile speed camera is to be sited on area outside Horsebridge Avenue. Order more '20 is plenty' signs.</p> <p>c. A request from residents regarding the safety of children on Village Street, Aldington and crossing Bretforton Road- This was also sent to County Councillor Alastair Adams who has arranged for Highways to visit and requested lengthsman to cut back vegetation.</p>
