

6	<p><u>CALC</u> There had been a Zoom meeting but neither Chair Bewsher or the Clerk attended as there appeared to be little on the Agenda relevant to BPPC. The Minutes of the meeting had not yet been issued.</p>
7	<p><u>Road Safety Campaign</u> Chair Bewsher and Cllr Meads met with Bob Haines, Paul Green and Paul Waterhouse on Wednesday 25th January 2023. The take away from the meeting was that the police confirmed they would enforce a 40ph speed limit, contrary to the statement by WCC. Following the meeting, Chair Bewsher sent a document justifying why the lane should be 40mph to Paul Green of WCC on 30th January 2023. We still await a response.</p>
8	<p><u>Community Governance review</u> Following the outcome of the Judicial review meaning that the Foxlydiat development will go ahead, Chair Bewsher had spoken to Darren Whitney, Electoral Services Manager at BDC, regarding boundary changes as the new development will change BPPC from a small rural Parish to a greatly increased Parish with completely differing needs and requirements. This is clearly something that BDC haven't even thought about and Chair Bewsher asked the Councillors if they were happy for herself and Cllr Cheape to attend a meeting with Mr Whitney to discuss this. All Councillors agreed to the meeting. Vice Chair Spence said if Cllr Cheape was unable to attend, he would stand in for him at the meeting.</p>
9	<p><u>Police / SNT Update</u> Cllr Boss had nothing to report.</p>
10	<p><u>Lengthsman</u> Mr Cooke advised it was the usual ongoing problem of reporting issues and nothing happening. WCC Cllr Taylor asked Mr Cooke to copy him in on reports and he would try and chase them. Richard Cenci has replaced Richard Clewer and Mr Cooke is building up a good working relationship with him. WCC have agreed to pay the cost of Mr Cooke digging out the ditch on Angel Street. The junction of Copyholt Lane & Black Lane – Highways have accepted responsibility and Mr Cooke is trying to get the authority to carry out the work. The drain on London Lane is on Mr Mays land and WCC will be writing to him asking him to clear the ditch around it.</p>
11	<p><u>Planning & Consultations</u></p>
a)	<p><u>Cur Lane Farm</u> Chair Bewsher submitted a further 4 documents to the Planning Inspectorate Appeal, we are still awaiting the outcome.</p>
b)	<p><u>23/00222/FUL</u> – The Long Barn, Birchfield Road – single storey detached 2 bay garage – Cllrs had no objection to this application with the caveat that the tree which is being removed be resituated at another point within the site.</p>
