The Minutes of Upper Arley Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 25th March 2025 at Arley Memorial Hall. The meeting commenced at 7.00 p.m.

The meeting was preceded by a presentation from The Police and Crime Commissioner, John Campion, who provided information on the role of the Commission followed by a session listening to Members views around Policing and providing answers to any issues raised.

- **1. Apologies:** Apologies were received from District/County Cllr D Morehead.

- 3. Community Policing: PCSO Marc Ginder gave the Police report. He advised that the only calls received in the past month related to domestic matters, nothing relating to theft, criminal damage etc. Nationally, there had been an increase in the theft of trailers and he recommended the use of GPS trackers to protect property. It was agreed that the Policing priority for the next three months would be a more visible Police presence.
