6.1	<p>Apologies: Carole Warren (accepted).</p>
6.2	<p>Declaration of Interest: None. There were no Dispensation requests.</p>
	<p>Public Question Time: The question referred to highways and was dealt with under that heading. None.</p>
6.3	<p>Minutes: The minutes of the meeting held on January 14th 2025 were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairwoman.</p>
6.4	<p>District and County Councillors' Reports: A written report from the County Councillor David Chambers was circulated to councillors prior to the meeting. District Councillors reported on the plans for Worcestershire to become a unitary authority. The District Council will no longer exist and Parish Councils' workload is expected to increase. There is a plan for Worcestershire to combine with Gloucestershire and Warwickshire in order to be represented by a Mayor. There was discussion on the number of homes being built in the villages locally and the effect on local infrastructure particularly with regard to education and medical services.</p>
6.5	<p>Midland Automobile Club: The agenda had been sent to the MAC, there was no report.</p>
6.6	<p>Highways and Footpaths: The landowners who cleared fallen trees from the Worcestershire Way were thanked. The annual Shelsley Walsh footpath closure notification was circulated, no comment. Concern was noted that a spring above the Manor Lane exit is causing problems with freezing. WCC to be contacted for advice. The Lengthsman's Report regarding the clearing of the culvert near Brockhill Court was noted and worksheets for January and February accepted. Village Walk reminder April 6th. Flood warning signs and depth indicators. The clerk to write again to WCC. The road closure near All Saints' will be closed on April 14th for one day. Road flooding at Shelsley Walsh is causing problems again, the Brockhill Estate to be notified.</p>
