7. Parish Council:

- a. Update from land committee including: Official opening, hedges, signage and metal seating together with section 106 application-
 - Official opening will take place on 12th May 2022 for stakeholders and anyone involved in the project with a further parish opening on 14th May 2022.
 - A volunteer has agreed to build the well and use donated bricks from Steve Underhill. AT is looking into a pump to draw water to water trees awaiting a start date.
 - 3 bins have been donated from Wychavon and a brown bin for BG vegetation has been ordered.
 - The first burial has successful taken place with no issues.
 - Kerbing and driveway to allotments has been completed, water troughs have been installed and water pipe piped to BG perimeter, 2nd pond has been dug and scrape completed.
 - Orchard trees have been planted and an additional hedge between allotments and orchard area.
 - Bee poles need to be erected and compost bins built.
 - On the suggestion of our drainage professional, a 2nd trench has been dug alongside the burial ground fence to check the line of land drains, a battered pipe was found lower than ditch which was blocked as advised by EA.
 - Application for £6372 has been submitted to Wychavon for the release of section 106 funds for public open space for wrought iron BG benches x2, recycled brown benches x6, planters x8, information signs x3 and interpretation board x1.
 - A couple of residents were interested to see progress, if anyone would like to come and look around, councillors are more than happy to accompany them and explain progress.

- b. Co-option of parish councillor- 2 potential candidates were asked to leave the meeting while this matter was considered so that all 5 candidates were considered and treated equally and fairly. 5 candidates were considered with a secret vote taken. Paul Allen was co-opted onto Badsey PC with 5 votes of the 11 councillors.
- c. Events Committee Update including Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations and residents' suggestions- It was agreed not to run Easter Event this year as not enough councillors could commit to the day. A further meeting needs to be arranged for jubilee arrangements. Soapbox will run on Sunday 28th August 2022 with further updates. Christmas event is confirmed as Friday 16th December 2022.
- d. The following policies were approved, proposed by DW, seconded by ID with a unanimous vote in favour:
 - 1. Equality & Diversity
 - 2. Health & safety
 - 3. Risk Management.
- e. The naming of 8 houses at the rear of Ivanhoe, Blackminster as 'Apple Blossom Way' was ratified.
- f. Unauthorised parish council reports in Community News- A report was published in March 2022 Community News which was not written by PC and used words from the minutes to provide an update which were not re-written correctly. Cllrs unanimously agreed that if the PC do not submit any report then the following wording should be used: 'At the time of printing Badsey & Aldington Parish Council had not submitted a report. The PC can be contacted by emailing badseypc@yahoo.co.uk or by telephoning 07591533557 Monday to Thursday 9.30am to 3pm or looking at www.badseypc.uk. Meetings are held on 3rd Wednesday of the month except in August at Badsey Remembrance Hall.'
