District Councillor-

- Boundary review is likely to be delayed with details not being available until end of year. This is for ward boundary changes ONLY.
- 2nd stage of payments via council tax are due for those most in need.
- A number of enforcements matters are still ongoing.

b. Community Speed Watch- It was agreed that having received no more volunteers that a post should go on FB advising that the opportunity is coming to an end.

7. Parish Council:

- a. Land update-
- a. Section 106 application-Grant of £6372 has been approved and will be ratified with Wychavon's Executive Board next week and then released.
- b. Progress Interpretation boards have now been installed as well as 3 bins. Clerk has chased recycling bin at allotments and toilets. Meeting is being arranged to discuss how to resolve the issue of no water in wildlife ponds. Quote has been received for £1k to strim around all trees and hedges and spray to allow for growth. It was unanimously agreed to get this work done. Clerk will check if tree surgeons dispose of chippings and if so, if they can be used as a mulch around trees. Consideration needs to be given to cost for memorial tree planting-next agenda.
- Events Committee Update-Soapbox.-ID will contact sponsors and a meeting will be set up for other actions. 2 entries have been received so far with a further 2-3 pending.
 Consideration was given to a roadsweep but it was agreed not to proceed.

- Jubilee Events- Invoices need to be submitted for payment for all events that involved all residents if they need re-imbursing up to a total of £359 (Wychavon grant).
- c. Badsey Flower Show stall arrangements- Councillors were confirmed as: MiT, DW, SK, PA and PC-MiT will produce photos for a photo board of events and progress this year.
- d. Code of Conduct-new code of conduct as provided by Wychavon legal services was adopted as read, proposed by ID, seconded by GB with a unanimous vote in favour.
- e. 'Stfafing committee'- It was unanimously agreed to set up a staffing committee to review staff progress and achievements and development areas. GB and SK agreed to be on the committee which will review clerk annually before May meeting and present report to full council for approval rather than lengthy discussion at meeting. Another committee member and agreeing terms of reference will be agreed at July meeting.
- f. Supporting the use of Badsey Rangers changing rooms for 'The Fraser Bennett Charitable Foundation' as per information and Public Forum update- MiT proposed, seconded by GB with a unanimous vote in favour.

"Badsey PC has the same comments to make as on the previous application the same location for the same number of houses as follows:

- 1. The site is outside SWDP.
- 2. Although site may be a "preferred option" it was not agreed by the PC.
- 3. It would lead to substantial additional traffic on the very busy Bretforton Rd. As usual, totally unrealistic expectations are expressed with regard to use of bus services, cycling and walking. It is unlikely that residents are going to allow their children to walk along the Bretforton Rd school (especially as it would entail having to cross the road to stay on pavement). Most of the residents would drive to local facilities.
- 4. Agreeing to this development would make it more difficult to justify objecting to other proposed developments in Badsey e.g. behind 1 Bretforton Rd."
