6.4 Highways, Footpaths and Lengthsman:

Lengthsman. The worksheets for November (received late) January and February were inspected and agreed. The culvert by the Village Hall has been cleared.

Ham Bridge visibility. The sign agreed by WCC has not yet been installed at the junction.

6.5 District Councillor's Report: District Councillor Farmer reported on the increased catalytic converter thefts particularly from high vehicles.

Citizens Advice Bureau has a dedicated flooding helpline.

Housing in the county. The county must provide 23,000 new homes, parishes should be aware. The Parish Council is concerned about housing built on flood plains and hopes that future development will be on brown field sites.

6.6 Environment Agency and Flooding: Information from the Environment Agency stated that riparian owners are responsible for clearing debris from New Mill Bridge unless damage is being caused.

The Winnington Estate has cleared the blockage which caused problems on Kingswood Lane. MHDC has issued a press release for small and medium sized companies affected by the recent flooding.
