Minutes of the Annual Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 10th July 2017 in the Fisher Hall.

81/17 Apologies

To consider acceptance of apologies for absence from Councillors: Cllr Mr T White (accepted), also Mr C Penn (Malvern Hills Conservators)

82/17 Interests

i. Councillors Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPI) and Other Disclosable Interests (ODI) regarding items on the agenda: Cllr Turner declared an ODI on planning application 17/00891/HP since he was a neighbour.

ii. Notification of changes to the register of interests: There were none.

iii. To consider written requests from councillors for the council to grant a dispensation for those with Disclosable Interests to take part in discussions or voting: Cllr Turner to discuss planning application 17/00891/HP. This was agreed and would last until the next ordinary election.

83/17 Reports from other representatives

To receive reports from County and District Councillors, Malvern Hills Trust, Tree and Footpaths Wardens and other representatives:

Clirs. Raine and McVey reported that, since the Grenfell Tower fire, Fortis Housing were investigating cladding to the exterior of their properties and also the Premier Inn Malvern where some families are housed. Also the planning application for four houses at 54 West Malvern Road had been rejected by MHDC. They had met with 69 residents at West Fest on 1st July and MHDC were looking to include recycling of black plastics.

Cllr. Raine also reported on a meeting with Hannah Davies, the new Highways liaison officer, and confirmed that two 20mph flashing signs were planned to be installed outside the primary school before September.

To consider for adoption the minutes of the last Parish Council meeting: The minutes of the meeting held on 12th June were approved and signed by the Chairman.

85/17 Progress Reports and other matters arising from the minutes: The Clerk reported that he had contacted Admiral Taverns who confirmed that, following resident's complaints, live music had been suspended at the Brewers Arms.

Secondly, although provision is made for off road parking, ingress and egress will be compromised by poor visibility, firstly by the road layout and secondly since access will cross a dedicated on road parking area whose capacity will be reduced by at least two spaces."
