### 3. Chairman introduction and progress on the Character Assessment:

Chairman thanked all for attending and wished to thank everyone for carrying out the massive exercise in obtaining over 800 photographs of important landscape and views in the Parish of Church Lench. This is tremendous progress in obtaining information to be able to protect green spaces and valued landscapes in the Parish.

**Sheriffs Lench**: yet to be considered. Volunteers required from the hamlet. Chairman has started to write up the character assessment.

Geoff Dainty and Chairman will be looking at rights of way in the Parish.
