1. APOLOGIES were received from Cllrs S Kottler and S Britten

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST - None

3. MINUTES from the previous meeting were approved and signed

4. PROGRESS REPORTS

- a) Highway Matters
 - Speeding / Speed Data The clerk had received a quantity of *30mph/slow down* stickers for wheelie bins. It was agreed that these be distributed to homes on the main roads, two per property in the first instance, with extras provided if requested.
 - Pool Close County Cllr Hardman would investigate why this is not in the current surface dressing programme
 - Deer Sign it was considered that the sign was in the wrong place. The clerk would ask CC to move it
- *b*) Footpaths/Rights of Way The Footpath Warden advised that now the weather was improving, work would commence on keeping overgrowth under control
- c) Lengthsman:
 - Weedkiller/tools approval was given to pay £40 for weed-killer and £21.66 (one sixth contribution for tools)
 - Manor Lane- the clerk would ask him to keep on top of verges an the entrances to the paddocks in Manor Lane
- d) Planning:
 - The Old Post Office / Old Shop Awaiting decision by WDC re retrospective planning
 - The Grange, Wick Road A new planning application is awaited for the building of a new garage.
 - Orchard View, Manor Lane fence line to be reduced.
 - Great Comberton Golf Club notification from the planning inspector had been received. It was agreed that support would be offered to Great Comberton if needed
 - 18 /00761 Ringsmere Orchard Alterations to existing garage discussion took place and it was
 agreed that although the footprint of the existing garage was reduced, the height was increased, and
 that the design was very much industrial-style on a key approach to the village. Furthermore,
 concerns were noted that remedial works to reduce the visual impact of an extension built without
 planning permission had not yet been completed, despite the approval of a retrospective planning
 application.
