1. Apologies: Apologies had been received from Cllr Mrs P. Stone and D. Saunders and County and District Cllr L. Tucker.

3. Planning

a) To discuss and comment on current planning applications:

19/02622/RM	Land off Chestnut Close,	Application for approval of all reserved matters following outline

The councillors felt that they were unable to accept the application as it stood and resolved to object for the following reasons:

There were considerable concerns over drainage, both the retention of existing drainage for the village and for the development. The development was situated in the vicinity of the main drainage exit point for the village and it was vitally important that this was not compromised. The council had concerns that the new homeowners would be unaware of their responsibilities as riparian owners or that they may not keep up with the maintenance, potentially risking the drainage system for many other households. There was no information on who would be responsible for the balancing pond.

Many of the drawings submitted were either marked as Draft or Working Copy and the council felt that the final versions should be available for consideration.

The road layout was longer than necessary, to the boundary of the development field with the next. The council did not want to see development in the next field so wished the road to end at the last house in the development. There were also concerns that heavy vehicles would damage the underground storm drain as it was not very deep in the ground.
