	<p><b>BACKGROUND FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES</b>  This is an application for heavy good vehicles to be kept at Rosehaven, Badsey. Several local residents have started a campaign to oppose this application on traffic and noise grounds. Mr Hill of The Old Vicarage, Manor Road, Wickhamford WR11 7SA is the spokesman. It was decided that the Parish Council would give Mr Hill its support and allow Mr Hill to act on behalf of the Council in this regard.  Sherry Webb will attend the transport forum on 30/11 and voice an objection. David Folkes will represent the Council in the Planning committee. The application is a complex one and involves both planning permission and license issues.  <b>12/1/05</b> – Planning approval for the current situation to continue has been given but not for any additional lorries.
