- 6. District and County Councillor Forum (if any)
 District Councillor-
 - Planning application 20/00724/OUT, The Neuk, Bretforton Road, Badsey has been refused although the application for 34 houses is still being considered. As a review of SWDP, Wychavon are considering the provision of starter homes which may ensure that this application can be refused. Many of the points are the same in both applications but they may seek to get this through at appeal using a loophole in relation to starter homes.
 - District Councillor is still monitoring the applications at 10 Badsey Fields Lane.
 - Wychavon Annual Council Meeting has now been scheduled via zoom for w/c 20th July 2020.
 This will including the changing of Chairperson.

7. Parish Council-

- a. Land update including extension of PWLB drawdown date request- Planning Application is scheduled to be considered by planning committee on 20th August 2020, this has been delayed due to waiting for the updated response from EA using the correct map. Some 20+ comments have been made on the application 3 weeks after the closing date by residents. PWLB expires on 24th August 2020 but application is in place for an extension if required. All legal paperwork has now been returned to solicitor. An updated has been requested and provided to Wychavon regarding and delays during Covid19 which may affect the Community Legacy Grant drawdown. GB responded to this request in clerk's absence.
- b. Community News- It was agreed to make a six monthly contribution of £100 and review in January 2021. AW proposed, ID seconded with a unanimous vote in favour.
- c. Re-opening of play areas following government guidance notes-Lengthy discussion took place as to whether the PC are in a position to re-open the play areas safely following the assessment of government guidelines. Two examples of posters that have been displayed elsewhere were considered but many others are available. Play areas are being used at this time even though they are closed. MiT advised that the PC would be seen in a negative way if we couldn't re-open. Badsey Rec Club have already emailed asking for the PC to provide reasons if the play areas cannot be opened. It was agreed that whatever action was decided, that all residents would be advised through social

media and other methods and the reasoning behind it. GB proposed with 8 votes in favour and 2 against to check with CALC as to whether the posters are acceptable and what liability the PC would have in the event of uses catching the virus from equipment. This response together with anything that is suggested will be passed to all councillors and all councillors will need to respond with their views as to whether they now wish play areas to open. a. The minutes of the 17th June 2020 were noted.
