PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

MINUTES:

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION.

- 1. Re-opening of Village Play Areas-** Two councillors called an extra-ordinary meeting to further consider the re-opening of play areas. All cllrs have been regularly updated with information from insurers, CALC and government portal, no further information will be forthcoming to affect any decision. Cllr Collins advised that despite the fact that the play areas are closed, that there are many children regularly in the play area at Bretforton Club who have used chairs to climb over the 2feet fence despite the equipment being sealed off and notices

displayed. Cllr Collins is concerned that if the play areas are re-opened, that the rules will not be adhered to. Clerk advised that the general feedback is that once the PC open them and follow suggested protocols with risk assessments and signage that the responsibility passes to the users any parents.

Cllr Smith proposed, seconded by Cllr Appleby that both areas be re-opened as soon as is practical and following all the necessary guidelines to be covid19 safe. All in favour. Clerk detailed suggested signage and Cllr Davis agreed to assist with risk assessments. The signs for individual pieces of equipment can then be ordered and installed. Cllr Collins agreed to remove chains etc when required. Cllr Smith suggested that the risk assessments be submitted to Environment Health for their support. Cllr Wright advised that he thought that the re-opening should be regularly reviewed at future PC meetings, signage will say that areas can be closed immediately if rules are not adhered to. Clerk agreed to forward suggested posters immediately after meeting for cllrs approval. It was also suggested that a message on 'Spotted Bretforton' would be useful as a means of advising residents.
