PROGRESS REPORTS FOR INFORMATION.

Clerk:

• **Precept-** Clerk confirmed the agreed increase of precept to £29225, proposed by Cllr Grant, Seconded by Cllr Curry. All in favour. Absent Cllrs were contacted to advise and receive any objections. None were received.

Chairman;

- Bretforton Parish Council wish to send their best wishes to the family involved in the incident today in Bretforton. Their thoughts are with the 2 children and the family and wish them a speedy recovery.
- Play Area equipment relocation: Cllr Smith has removed play equipment from rec and re-sited suitable equipment at The Fleece. This has reduced contractor invoice by £800. Part of the equipment has been stolen and thus Cllr Smith will require to repair the equipment at his own cost as well as pay for the removal and re-siting of the equipment. It was therefore unanimously agreed by all Cllrs with an abstention from Cllr Smith that the matter should be considered as closed. The concrete bases have been kindly broken up by a willing volunteer.
- Play Area Repairs-It was unanimously agreed to consider an odd-job person to complete works at both play areas. Cllr Adams provided a contact that can be considered. Clerk to contact him.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION.

- 1. **Memorial Hall- i.** Wall and Door. Cllrs Davis and Cleveland have carried out site visit, Cllr Davis will provide a specification of works for a further quotation to be requested.
- 2. Village Marker- Cllrs have had a proposal of village marker to consider as follows; a wooden post with steel asparagus painted and galvanised and sited on the grass at The Cross. The cost will be between £300 and £500 but only a 10% increase for two. It was agreed that Cllr Davis will provide a location plan, Cllr Grant will obtain exact quotation for next meeting and Clerk will contact Worcester CC to ask permission for it to be erected
- 3. **Facebook-** A PC Facebook page was considered, Cllrs Cleveland and Lisney agreed to work together to set up and maintain.
- 4. **Sports Club-** i. Car Park-Letter to contractor. It was unanimously agreed to not send a letter as car park still has issues.
 - **ii. Donation to Parish Games** It was unanimously agreed to make a donation of £200 towards the parish games celebrations. Proposed by Cllr Wright, seconded by Cllr Grant. All in favour.
- 5. **Bretfest 2016-** Constitution information has been provided and is satisfactory. It was agreed that PC would respond as follows: *We would like to continue supporting you in*

your endeavours in the appropriate way and look forward to receiving further details of the event.

- 6. **Play Provision at Recreation Ground Play Area-** A request from a resident for play equipment for under 3's to be added to play area was considered. It was unanimously agreed that as the PC currently have an insurance claim outstanding for replacement of a toddler piece of equipment, the matter would be re-assessed when this equipment has been installed.
- 7. **Verges-Weston Road, Main Street.** Clerk raised correspondence relating to two sites in the village that have issues with verges. Firstly, on Weston Road outside bungalow being renovated. Builders lorries have churned up verge and used access on Weston Road. It was unanimously agreed to request resident to restore verge and re-seed when work has been completed. Verge-Main Street-Further email regarding verge, Chairman has again inspected in evening. Other action is as follows: Presence of PCSO, letters to residents, note in magazine and regular inspections during the day and night. PC have considered posts, benches etc. in order to preserve this verge however, this would not be approved by Highways, it was therefore agreed that the PC could take no further action.

- Section 106 monies- Clerk confirmed that the following section 106 funds are currently being held: Arts & Culture, £3706.44, off-site built sports & leisure, £20509.66 and off-site formal sport, £31663.78.
- Flood Alleviation Support Grant scheme- A further request had been received from Wychavon for parishes to consider applying for this grant. It was unanimously agreed to not consider this scheme further.
