MINUTES:

Minutes of the Meeting held on 9th May 2016 were circulated. Proposed by Cllr Grant seconded by Cllr Wright. All in favour to accept the minutes.

PROGRESS REPORTS FOR INFORMATION.

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Clerk;

• Audit of Burial Ground Memorials-Clerk advised that the annual audit of memorials had been carried out by Cllr Davis and clerk. 8 memorials had been identified as requiring attention. Chris @ Memory Lane memorials has been instructed to carry out the works asap because of health & safety concerns. The fixed deposit held by PC for Burial Ground maintenance has been re-invested, £500 has been taken out to be allocated for repairs.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION.

- 1. **Tree planting-** Cllr Davis provided a schedule of proposed tree planting and replacing a number of dead trees for consideration by cllrs. Cllrs were asked to consider proposals and any other ideas for next meeting. Cllr Davis will forward a map to Cllrs Carter and Curry to look at area along Weston Road.
- 2. **Stoneford Lane Junction-** Assessment of junction has been carried out by Worcs CC. No accidents have been reported at this junction in past 3 years. SLOW markings will be painted on and 'give way' markings re-traced.
- 3. **New Homes Bonus** It was unanimously agreed that an information event will run on Monday 12th September 2016 at 6.30pm immediately before PC meeting for residents to share ideas/comment on ideas. Matter will be discussed at next meeting. Date will be put in magazine and details of possible projects in next month's magazine.
- 4. Bretforton Proms- Details of this year's event were read out.
- 5. **Lengthsman-** It was unanimously agreed to not consider a second lengthsman at this time but to discuss asuitable programme with lengthsman. Cllr Davis and clerk will carry this out. Small jobs will be given to handyman so as to free up lengthsman especially in busy periods.
- 6. Bretforton School Art Competition- Cllr Smith has confirmed that the school are happy to support an art project to raise village awareness of dog poo issues. It was unanimously agreed that clerk would contact school immediately and detail the following:

i. Prize fund of £25 in vouchers for either 1st and 2nd prize or 1st, 2nd, 3rd. ii. A4 posters to be produced by children to be submitted to PC to be judged at PC meeting on 11th July 2016.

iii. A4 can be anything relating to dog poo issues but not computer generated.

iv. Pupils names and class details need to be on reverse.

v. Presentation will be before end of school term, posters will be printed over the summer on weatherproof A5 boards and put up around village in September.

- 7. Quotations for toddler swing- It was unanimously agreed to accept quotation of £3771.09 including VAT for Kompan basic slide. Included I this is a price of £429 for skip hire which PC agreed should be removed and either a local skip ordered or if not required, debris to be taken away by PC. Quote would only be accepted if zipwire can be re-tensioned. Proposed by Cllr Grant, seconded by Cllr Johnson.
- 8. **Dog Poo bins locations-** It was unanimously agreed to request new bins for Back Lane/Drinkwater Lane and Weston Road opposite Collingwood garage at start of footpath. Proposed by Cllr Cleveland, seconded by Cllr Grant.
- 9. Tasks list for handyman- Cllr Davis provided a list for handyman as follows;
 - i. Remove all mortar and bits from pavement by wall on New Street, Bretforton opposite Honeybourne Road junction
 - ii. Fix 'No Dogs' sign (currently propped up) onto the footpath post. (corner of rec nearest Clayfield Road)
 - iii. Clean out bus shelters, particularly on New Street.

- iv. Check loose boards and re-stain bus shelters starting with Coldicotts Lane.
- v. Clean down and restore bench under oak tree on New Street by shop. (retreat after rubbing down)
- vi. Repaint (clear off ivy first) circular seat in The Triangle, Station Road/Shop Lane.
- vii. Repaint circular seat on green by The Fleece.
- viii. Cut down ivy on memorial trees in rec and clear off sign fixed to tree and remove cherry tree seedlings in field opposite the Barn, Main Street (outside our planted area)
- 10. Village Sculpture- Cllr Grant provided quotations for sculpture and installation of £2260 with any additional sculpture at a cost of £1800. Cllr Wright proposed and Cllr Curry seconded with a unanimous vote in favour to accept the quote as soon as permission is received from Rachael Benson at Worcs CC. It also agreed that clerk should ask Cllr Adams to chase this matter. Section 1096 monies for Public Arts & Culture can be used for this project.
