#### **District Council:**

- £50k is available under Community Grants scheme for individual projects. The emphasis is on physical activity such as sports equipment or kit. For major projects, attendance at briefing on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2017 is required but not for smaller projects.
- The tidy Britain project has been launched to encourage clean-up around towns and villages.
- 120,000 tonnes of waste was cleared in 2016.
- 319 enforcements
- 694 flytipping incidents. It cost £30k to clear major flytipping.

#### **ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION.**

1. Allotment Land-a. Sub-Committee-All cllrs have received an update via meeting minutes. Quote has now been received for car park. NHB application can now be submitted, Proposed by Cllr Carter, seconded by Cllr Curry with a unanimous vote in favour to proceed. Magazine-The Clerk has several pages of allotment info, clerk to scan and send to all councillors for information.

**b. Update on Progress-** Cllr Davis confirmed that planning application can now be submitted with sheds included. The decision of whether to include sheds at a later date.

- 2. Village Sculpture/marker- Cost of sculpture and installation is £2260 plus vat. It was agreed to check if S106 monies for Arts and Culture is still available. Next agenda.
- 3. **Burial Ground- a- Fees-** It was unanimously agreed to approve the slight increase in fees in line with other authorities as detailed with a reduction to FOC for stillborns and children under 12. All funeral directors, the church and stonemasons will be advised. Proposed by Cllr Wright, seconded by Cllr Grant.

**b. Burial Criteria.** It was unanimously agreed to keep the burial criteria unchanged. Proposed by Cllr Wright with a unanimous vote in favour.

- 4. **Lengthsman-** In view of the fact that the advert was not published in magazine, it was agreed to extend deadline to Friday before April meeting.
- 5. **Mowing Rates-** It was unanimously agreed to accept new rates for amenity mowing and verges for 2017, Proposed by Cllr Curry, seconded by Cllr Cleveland, one abstention as follows:
  - Amenity Mowing- £245.00 per cut.
  - Verges Mowing- £180.00 per cut
  - Verges of Clayfield Road and Red Yat- £84.00 per cut

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## <u>County Councillor Report</u>- Bretforton Month: March 2017 Prepared by Alastair Adams Littletons Division, Worcestershire County Council

#### **Divisional Funds.**

As it is the end of the Council's financial year at the end of this month, there was a flood of applications for grants from local groups. I was pleased to be able to help them as follows:-

- 1. Honeybees WI have put in a request for some new tables grant processed
- 2. Cleeve Prior Wharf grant requested for life buoy, table and sign grant processed
- 3. Bretforton Community Shop want some paint to decorate their shop floors grant processed
- 4. Honeybourne Village Hall wanted some help to set up a rural cinema grant processed
- 5. Littletons Juniors want some help with a new football kit for the team, and some footballs grant processed
- 6. Cleeve prior Short Mat Bowls Club wanted some help with a new mat. The existing one is 30 years old grant processed
- 7. Bretfest Bretforton Music festival 15<sup>th</sup> 22<sup>nd</sup> July wanted some help with the hire of a piano for the event grant processed
- 8. Cleeve Prior Chroniclers wanted a document display stand to hold all the historical information on the village grant processed
- 9. Pebworth Rural Cinema wanted some help with a new BluRay player and marketing material grant processed
- 10. Offenham Youth Club awaiting more info will have to wait now for the WCC new financial year.

#### **Highways issues :-**

- 1. Coldicotts Close. Pavements repaired. In future Rooftop will maintain them and be responsible for them.
- 2. **Parking in New Street** –The Parish have decided to wait to see the outcome from the CCTV being installed in January before making any decision on extending the double yellow lines
- 3. Grass growing through new pavement in Coldicotts lane Highways have acknowledged that some remedial works need to be done, and are investigating.
- 4. Pot holes along B4035 Shop Lane / New Street / Weston Road, Bretforton 10 MPH Repairs, patching and resurfacing due on 18<sup>th</sup> March see attached maps.

#### Superfast Broadband - Cabinet 5 - copper ties upgrade needed

Once again the demand for Superfast Broadband is outstripping supply! The cabinet needs to be upgraded yet again. It turns out that more copper capacity is required in Badsey 5 cabinet (copper ties). Openreach have to 'de-load' and 'reload' the cabinet which will result in more copper (capacity) being available. Some civils are required which are booked in to complete on 16th March. Once the civils are completed the de-load / reload activity can begin and the expectation is that it will be completed by end of March. So anyone still wanting to upgrade to Superfast Broadband should be able to from April.
