- 3133 MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held on 13th September 2017 had been circulated. Cllr Mr P Langham proposed and seconded by Cllr Mr M Bates and it was AGREED that the minutes of the Parish Council meeting be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.
- 3134 PROGRESS REPORTS
- a. Police update (3121a) – PC Julie Jones reported that there had been no crimes to report in Stock & Bradley, there had been 7 breakins to outbuildings in Hanbury. PC Jones was also accompanied by Tracy Tooze, Business & Rural Officer, who has been appointed to support local business and farms. PC Jones agreed to do some spot speed checks and asked where the best place would be, Clerk agreed to update her.
 - b. Hanbury part of Earls Common Road (3121b) – a message had been received from Elaine Dicks, Deputy Returning Office, WDC to say that the letters will go out in December.
 - c. Level of water purity in Bow Brook / Lorries in Bradley Green (3121C) –The Clerk has been in contact with Mark Lane, Monitoring & Enforcement, Directorate of Economy & Infrastructure, WCC; who had visited the site of Matthew Coffin who operates Matt the Grab and has given him 8 weeks to find an alternative site, he has also added that there is nothing he can do with preventing lorries travelling through the village
 - d. Dog fouling in Stock and Bradley (3121D) – the clerk has ordered a waste bag dispenser to be positioned where the path from the Church meets Cyder Mill lane and to place an article outlining the dangers to farm animals.
 - e. Shredding of PC documents dating back to 1999 (312`E) – the Clerk had found a shredding company and would start this process.
 - f. Internet access and speeds (3125) – it is proposed that Fibre high speed access will be available for Bradley Green in December, there is no current news for Stock Green.
